- Coaches and managers – please wear club shirts or club jackets

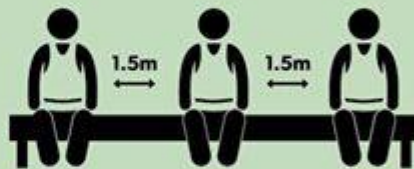
